Dear Producer:

On July 5, 2017, Cobra Pipeline Company, LTD notified Aspire Energy of Ohio that an application for a transportation rate increase on production flowing into their system was filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio in June 2016. As a result, Cobra Pipeline is authorized by law to raise its transportation charge from \$0.50/Dth to \$0.95/Dth. This rate increase went into effect with the July 2017 production period. As a result, Aspire Energy, in accordance with its gas purchase agreement, is forced to increase our transportation charges to recover the Cobra fees incurred for those volumes flowing into the Cobra system.

Also effective with the July 2017 production period is a 50% reduction in the Ohio Oil and Gas Energy Education Program assessment rate from \$0.01 per Mcf to \$0.005 per Mcf of natural gas.
